### PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Play by the rules – the rules of our club and the laws of the game.
2. Never argue with an umpire or other official – without these people, you can't play sport.
3. Control your temper – verbal abuse of officials and sledging other players doesn't help you win any games and will not be tolerated.
4. Be a team player – It is a team game so please treat it that way.
5. Treat all players and club members the way you would like to be treated – fairly.
6. Encourage all of your teammates and don't put them down.
7. Co-operate with your coach, the umpires and your teammates.
8. Be willing to learn and develop your skills.
9. Play the game to enjoy it and to improve your skills.
10. Don't use ugly remarks of anyone based on race, religion, gender or ability – you will let down your coach, teammates and family if you do. Many of these comments are now illegal.
11. Always represent KPSJFC proudly and in the best way you can on and off the field.

### PARENTS/GUARDIANS/SPECTATORS & MEMBERS CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Remember, this is JUNIOR SPORT and we are not PROFESSIONALS. Kids are out there to have fun not to win the AFL or Super Netball Premiership.
2. Encourage participation but don't force it.
3. Teach that enjoyment is more important than winning.
4. Never ridicule mistakes or losses – supporters are there to support not to downgrade.
5. Lead by example and respect all players, coaches, umpires and spectators – physical or verbal abuse will not be tolerated. Please control your temper.
6. Recognise and understand that all volunteers (inc. Committee and Coaches) are giving up their valuable time for your kids.
7. Please be prepared to help and volunteer on match day (and other jobs around the club when required). Without parents filling match roles, the team cannot take to the field.
8. Don't use ugly remarks of anyone based on race, religion, gender or ability – you will let down your coach, teammates and family if you do. Many of these comments are now illegal.
9. Always represent KPSJFC proudly and in an exemplary manner.

Any fines incurred during the season to any KPSJFC player, parent, or spectator will be invoiced to that person.
